Eligibility Criteria for study in 2023

	Criteria	Y/N
1.	Evidence of current registration with the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia is supplied.	
2.	Evidence of Australian Citizen or Permanent Resident status is supplied.	
3.	Evidence of link to Australian Defence Force is supplied. Applicant is current or ex-service personnel or a family member of an ex-service person	
4.	Level of education is Postgraduate at a recognised Australian university.	
5.	Course of study is related to contemporary nursing practice involving the care of older people and/or palliative care.	
6.	An ongoing commitment to professional practice in two or more of the following ways is shown: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Member of a professional nursing association or special interest group.• Contributes to the ongoing development of the team in which they work.• Actively involved in innovations in professional practice.• Recent involvement in research or presentations at conferences.• Makes a significant contribution to community service.	
7.	Priority for a scholarship award will be given to nurses who are committed to working in rural or regional areas on completion of their education program.	
8.	All sections of the Scholarship Application Form are completed.	
9.	The application is received by 31 st August, 2022.	
10.	Scholarship application is looked upon favourably if the applicant is a member of the ANMC.
