### Eligibility Criteria

Evidence of current registration with the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia is supplied.	
Evidence of Australian Citizen or Permanent Resident status is supplied.	
Level of study is doctoral research at a recognised Australian university.	
Education activity is related to contemporary professional practice in nursing or midwifery.	
Evidence of enrolment or offer of admission as a postgraduate research candidate at an accredited tertiary institution.	
The candidate is not in receipt of any other grant or scholarship.	
An ongoing commitment to professional practice in <b>two or more</b> of the following ways is shown: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Member of a professional nursing association or special interest group.</li><li>• Contributes to the ongoing development of the team in which they work.</li><li>• Actively involved in innovations in professional practice.</li><li>• Recent involvement in research or presentations at conferences.</li><li>• Makes a significant contribution to community service.</li></ul>
