INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS

The 21 Hearts Scholarship, valued at \$7,500, will be awarded to a registered nurse wishing to pursue further postgraduate studies or research in oncology.

The naming of the scholarship honours the 21 nurses who lost their lives during the Second World War in the Bangka Island Massacre and Vivian Bullwinkel, whose resilience continues to be an inspiration to so many.

Eligibility

This scholarship provided to support postgraduate study is open to nurses and midwives who hold current registration with the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia. For further details, please refer to the eligibility criteria.

The scholarship will be paid in two instalments (March and August) in the year of study. Academic Progress Report or a certified copy of the university transcript demonstrating satisfactory progress is required in July and December of the scholarship year.
