ANMC Scholarships for study in 2024

- Vivian Bullwinkel Award **\$20,000**
- Betty Jeffrey Award **\$15,000**
- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Nurse/Midwife Scholarship **\$5,000**
- Mental Health Scholarship **\$5,000**
- Commemorative Scholarship **\$5,000**

Study Subject: Nursing or midwifery practice

Level: Postgraduate – Coursework or Research

Eligibility:

These scholarships are for study in Australia. They are open to nurses and midwives who are citizens or permanent residents of Australia and hold current registration with the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia (NMBA). Please refer to the Eligibility Criteria for each scholarship available at our website.

Payment Information:

The scholarship will be paid in two instalments (March and August) in the year of study. Academic Progress Report or a certified copy of the university transcript demonstrating satisfactory progress is required in July and December of the scholarship year.
