## INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS

The **Michael Dent Scholarship** is generously sponsored by Mrs. Sandra Dent, a retired nurse, local St Kilda Road resident and supporter of the ANMC. This scholarship is awarded in honour of her late husband, Michael Dent.

Michael John Dent was born in Hull, Yorkshire England in 1948 and brought up in New Zealand. Michael died in an accident in December 1998 aged 50.

Mrs. Sandra Dent studied nursing and midwifery in New Zealand. Since retirement, Sandra has taken a keen interest in all things nursing. Sandra is sponsoring this scholarship in her late husband's name and to support someone wishing to advance their practice in nursing or midwifery.

### **The Michael Dent Scholarship (\$5,000) will be awarded for postgraduate study**

**Study Subject:** Patient/family-centred care in Victoria

**Level:** Postgraduate – Coursework or Research

#### **Eligibility**

- This scholarship provided to support postgraduate study is open to nurses and midwives who are resident and practising in Victoria and hold current registration with the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia (NMBA). See Eligibility Criteria

#### **Payment Information**

The scholarship will be paid in two instalments (March and August) in the year of study. Academic Progress Report or a certified copy of the university transcript demonstrating satisfactory progress is required in July and December of the scholarship year.
