



Rosemary Norman Grants

INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS

The ANMC is honoured to administer the **'Babe' Norman Scholarship**, awarded to nurses and midwives who have exceptional research potential to undertake a full-time PhD or doctorate at an Australian university, as well as **Rosemary Norman Grants**, that provide opportunities for applicants in the later stages of their PhD or other nursing or midwifery postgraduate course.

The purpose of the scholarship and the grants is to:

- encourage and assist nurses and midwives to further their education in Australia, , and
- promote the status of the nursing and midwifery professions in the community
- The 'Babe' Norman Scholarship and Rosemary Norman Research Grants are generously funded by the **Rosemary Norman Foundation**, established in 2008 by Miss Rosemary Havill Norman (1933–2021).

Rosemary Norman held an enduring dedication to nursing and commitment to further education for nurses and midwives, now perpetuated in the aims of the Foundation and scholarships named in honour of her late father, Reginald 'Babe' Havill Norman (1893–1973).

'Babe' Norman Scholarship

This three-year full-time scholarship provides the recipient with \$40,000 each year for 3 years, dependent upon ongoing successful progress, as determined by their PhD supervisor and university progress reports monitored by the ANMC. The award will total \$120,000 over three years.

Study Subject: Related to nursing or midwifery practice

Level: Postgraduate – Research

Eligibility:

The scholarship is for study in Australia. It is open to nurses and midwives who are citizens or permanent residents of Australia and hold current registration with the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia (NMBA). Please refer to the Eligibility Criteria on our website for further information.

Payment Information:

The scholarship is paid in two instalments (normally in March and August) in each of the three years of study. Progress Reports demonstrating satisfactory progress are required in July and December each year.

Rosemary Norman Grants

These grants provide opportunities for applicants in the later stages of their PhD or other nursing or midwifery postgraduate course. The funding available for these grants ranges from \$10,000–\$40,000.

Study Subject: Related to nursing or midwifery practice

Level: Postgraduate

Eligibility:

The grants are for study in Australia. They are open to nurses and midwives who are citizens or permanent residents of Australia and hold current registration with the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia (NMBA). Please refer to the Eligibility Criteria on our website for further information.

Payment Information:

The grants are paid in two instalments (normally in March and August) in the year of study. Academic Progress Report or a certified copy of the university transcript demonstrating satisfactory progress is required in July and December of the scholarship year.

Application Details:
